Tips

- 1. Start with *Hi* if it is an informal email to someone you know.
- 2. The email can have three main paragraphs:
  - the reason for writing (= to say thank you)
  - the main point (= more details or examples)
  - a wish or offer for the future.
- 3. Use emojis (e.g. 🕲) or emoticons (e.g. :) ) to show you're joking.





- 4. You can say See you soon / See you next year if you hope to meet again.
- 5. Use a closing phrase like Keep in touch, Write soon, Speak soon or Take care.
